

## **St. Stanislaus K – 8 Parish School of Religion (PSR) Program**

**Who is invited to attend?** Children currently enrolled in kindergarten through eighth grade, who are registered members of St. Stanislaus Church are welcome to participate in the program. Most students attend local public schools, but the program is open to those who attend parochial schools as well. The program is designed to supplement religious education taught in the home through a textbook curriculum.

**What are the dates and requirements I should know about?** Students meet on Wednesday nights in the St. Stanislaus School Library from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. Families are welcome to attend a family night at 6:30 p.m. on the final class of each month, also located in the Library. Students follow the “Christ Jesus, the Way” textbook series. Classes are led by parish volunteers who are experienced in teaching and VIRTUS trained by the Diocese of Jefferson City. Teachers are in charge of preparing the lesson of the week, which includes textbook material, active learning, songs, games, crafts and discussion to engage the students in learning more about their faith. Classes begin in the fall and go until the last Wednesday in April.
