

St. Stanislaus Reconciliation & First Communion Program

Who is invited to attend? Students currently enrolled in second grade, who are registered members of St. Stanislaus Church or St. Margaret Church and who have been baptized according to the Catholic Church, are welcome to participate in the program. Second grade students will complete lessons as part of their school curriculum, either as part of St. Stanislaus School or as part of St. Stanislaus Parish School of Religion (PSR).

What are the dates and requirements I should know about? Each first communicant and parent(s) will complete books selected by the parish as part of the school curriculum, attend an informational meeting in the fall regarding Reconciliation, be invited to a Pinning Ceremony or Mass and reception, attend Reconciliation Centers in the fall, make the Sacrament of Reconciliation prior to First Communion, attend an informational meeting after the new year regarding First Communion, attend First Communion centers with their parent(s) in the spring, schedule a meeting with Fr. Greg Meystrik regarding First Communion, and (should the child choose to take part in the parish First Communion Mass) participate in the First Communion Mass, held on a Sunday after Easter at a special time.
