

St. Stanislaus Sunday School Program

Who is invited to attend? Children age three to five, who are not currently enrolled in kindergarten, who are registered members of St. Stanislaus Church are welcome to participate in the program.

What are the dates and requirements I should know about? Children meet on Sunday mornings in the Sunday School Room (below the Gym in the school) during 10:30 Mass. The students follow the “Allelu!” program, which is a Catholic Christ-centered, multisensory program that introduces the lessons through the process of welcoming the child in, gathering them to become interested in the theme, discovering through interactive storytelling, exploring for themselves the themes, people, places, and things related to the lesson, and sending them forth to share what they have learned within their families. Each month the children are presented with a new theme and group of stories, accompanied by songs, crafts, coloring pages, and more that allow them to explore their relationship with God in a fun, age-appropriate environment. On the final Sunday of every month, the class will attend church together to become familiar with the behaviors and traditions of our Catholic faith. The class is led by a parent teacher and a parent assistant. The assistant helps the leader with crafts and cleanup, is responsible for bringing snack, and all parents are encouraged to take part in the assistant rotation.
